DORMITORY REGULATIONS

The purpose of the following regulations is to provide a positive living environment for all of our students. Many rooms are shared by multiple students, and the fulfillment of these rules will help create a proper and menschlich setting. We appreciate your cooperation in maintaining the Yeshiva's standards.

Cleanliness

All High School and Beis Medrash students are expected to maintain their rooms in a respectable fashion.

- 1. Beds are to be made each morning.
- 2. The floor of the room should be kept clear. Large suitcases should be placed in the storage rooms provided by the school, or underneath the beds.
- 3. All clothing should be placed in the closets or drawers. No clothing should be hanging on chairs or doors, laying on beds, or sticking out of the drawers.
- 4. We require all the boys to purchase a laundry bag to ensure a healthy living environment.
- 5. The common areas are reserved for the recreational use of all the students, and should not be used for storage of clothing or other personal items.

Food – Cooking

- 1. All food products are to be kept in the cabinets provided in the dorm's two kitchen areas.
- 2. In the interest of safety, there is to be no cooking on the premises without permission of the Rabbis.

Safety Measures

- 1. Students may not light fires for any purpose, in or around the dormitory *including candles, lighters, matches or cigarettes.*
- 2. Students are not permitted on the roof.
- Students are NOT allowed to leave the dormitory without permission from the Rabbis.
- 4. Gambling or alcohol of any kind is strictly prohibited.

Personal Responsibility

If damage to the dormitory, school furniture or building is caused by a student, the student will be responsible for the cost of the damage.

I have read the PTI Dormitory Regulations and agree to abide by the above rules. I realize that if I should fail to follow these guidelines I could be subject to a fine, suspension or expulsion.
